George and Dolores Eccles

George and Dolores (affectionately known as “Lolie” by her friends and family) Eccles were among Utah’s most admired and active civic leaders, and were deeply committed to improving the lives of people throughout the state. Their enduring legacy, built over six decades, reflects their vision, philanthropic spirit, and shared passion for giving. While this dynamic couple formed their foundation in 1958, it became most active in 1982 after George’s passing. From the beginning, the Foundation was established to focus on five key areas: arts and culture, community, education, health care, and preservation and conservation. The impact of their generosity, now exceeding \$800 million, continues to grow and benefit Utahns in countless ways.

Inspiration

We are inspired by the remarkable nonprofits working throughout our state who uplift and support Utahns in so many ways. From mentoring children to supporting young adults working towards a better life through education to enriching our communities through the arts, the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation is proud to support these organizations and the vital work they do.

SALT LAKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE / GRANGER HIGH PACE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

As Utah's largest high school, Granger High, in collaboration with Salt Lake Community College (SLCC), now hosts the PACE Scholarship program. Thanks to a \$600,000 grant from the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation, this transformative program supports first-generation and low-income students. Mentors and skill-building workshops focus on a growth mindset, self-confidence and belonging. Students begin their journey connecting with inspiring leaders, including Foundation President and COO, Lisa Eccles, SLCC President Dr. Greg Peterson, and Granger Principal Dr. Tyler Howe. Upon graduating, students receive a six-semester scholarship to SLCC. We're so excited to celebrate their future successes!



BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS

After serving kids in Tooele County for more than 20 years, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Salt Lake – Tooele campus finally has a place that hundreds of kids can call their own thanks to a \$300,000 grant from the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation. Ensuring youth have access to the services critically needed in the region, the new clubhouse has become a beacon of opportunity and connection. Youth ages 5-18 have access to STEM and computer labs, a full kitchen, games room, gym, dance room, and dedicated teen center.



ADOPT-A-NATIVE-ELDER

Over its 35-year history, the Adopt-a-Native-Elder Navajo Rug Show has helped more than 180 Navajo Elders sell over 5,000 woven rugs, jewelry and native crafts. From its humble beginnings, the program has grown into the world's largest not-for-profit Indigenous art show with 100% of the proceeds providing much-needed income to help elders survive the harsh winters on the reservation. The George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation has been a proud supporter, contributing almost \$600,000 since 1997 to help preserve this important cultural art form.



UTAH RISING

Our founders knew that the success of our state begins with a collaborative community and vibrant economy. The Salt Lake Chamber's Utah Rising statewide initiative doubles down on that premise. With public-private partnerships, including a \$250,000 grant from our Foundation and many others, Utah Rising is bringing the business community together to create an economic vision of success and sustainable growth over the next 10 years. This bold and exciting vision addresses critical issues with innovative, long-term solutions for all who call Utah home.





Collaboration

Utahns are known the world over for our commitment to service and collaboration. In that spirit, the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation partners with community leaders, nonprofits, government entities and fellow philanthropic organizations for positive change. Working in tandem, the result is a state that is dynamic, welcoming, and resilient.

TABERNACLE CHOIR AT TEMPLE SQUARE

For the first time ever, the acclaimed Tabernacle Choir at Temple Square joined with the voices from Morehouse and Spelman Colleges for a series of inspirational concerts in Salt Lake City and then again in Atlanta. The George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation was honored to support the events with a \$75,000 grant, bringing Morehouse and Spelman Glee Clubs to Utah. Hearing these storied institutions come together in song was a moving experience, uniting us all through the beauty of music. The strong bonds formed during the collaboration have been meaningful and lasting, reminding us of the power of community, faith and shared purpose.

NATURE CONSERVANCY

The George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation awarded its first contribution to The Nature Conservancy (TNC) in 1983. Since then, the Foundation has supported the organization's important work preserving the vital ecosystems, wildlife, and natural resources that make Utah so extraordinary. Our \$2 million grant to TNC's "Utah Futures Campaign" aims to address the evolving needs of Utah's landscapes and communities, including returning water to the Great Salt Lake, restoring critical habitat for wildlife, and increasing sustainable land and water management across the state. We are proud to join TNC, farmers and ranchers, state leaders, local agencies and others in this effort.

UTAH PRESERVATION HOUSING FUND

Faced with an acute housing shortage and rising housing costs, our state needs to build new homes as well as preserve our existing housing supply. The George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation was pleased to collaborate with other public and private investors to preserve and expand access to homes in Utah through a \$3 million PRI (program related investment) grant to the Utah Housing Preservation Fund. The Utah Preservation Housing Fund is working to increase the number of homes available to families at all income levels, creating a stable foundation for many of our state's residents.



RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE

For families facing the challenges of having hospitalized children, the new Ronald McDonald Family Room in Lehi offers a sanctuary within the hospital itself. Through collaborative support from our partner hospital, local community members, corporations, foundations, and service groups, Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Intermountain Area is able to serve over 3,000 pediatric patient families in Utah each year. Together, these partnerships, including a \$500,000 grant from the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation, help provide this essential family-centered care.





Impact

Our Foundation was established to serve Utahns and enrich the quality of life in our communities. Every nonprofit we support contributes to meaningful change and lasting impact. From addressing homelessness and clean air and water, to supporting families in need, our nonprofit partners truly help the people of Utah thrive.

SPENCER FOX ECCLES SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF UTAH

Board Chair and CEO Spence Eccles wisely said, “no state or region can become truly first-class without an academic medical center at its nucleus.” With that in mind, the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation, in partnership with the Nora Eccles Treadwell Foundation, committed a landmark \$110 million gift to build the new home for the University of Utah’s Spencer Fox Eccles School of Medicine. In 2024, and against the backdrop of some of the best health care education and medical services in the country, we placed the final beam on this extraordinary facility. When the 180,000 sq. foot state-of-the-art building is completed in 2026, the school will increase the number of graduates and provide leading edge programs and innovative learning opportunities to educate Utah’s future physicians. Our medical graduates will improve health in our state and region and provide the best treatments for their patients with care and compassion.



THE OTHER SIDE VILLAGE

The Other Side Village is a 430 small-home, self-reliant, master-planned neighborhood providing Salt Lake City's chronically homeless with an affordable, permanent housing option. This unique and effective approach hopes to change their lives for the better, helping to break the cycle of criminal behavior, substance abuse and homelessness. A \$300,000 gift from the Foundation will contribute to the installation of solar panels on each small home supporting both the message of independence for the residents and alignment with the state's initiative to build a more secure energy future for Utah.



BRIDGERLAND TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Bridgerland Technical College continues to inspire excellence in 2024, empowering students to pursue their passions and build successful careers through industry-focused education. The Foundation was pleased to grant \$20,000 in scholarships for the school's public services program, providing hands-on training, skill development, and leadership to those training for EMT, fire and rescue, and public safety programs, to make a real-world impact. The dedication of Bridgerland's students is a testament to the power of technical education in shaping the future of our workforce and community.



REDEMPTION BANK

In 2024, the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation – through a PRI (program related investment) grant – contributed \$3.5 million to support Redemption Holding Company. Redemption will be the first Black-owned bank between Houston and Los Angeles. Together, foundations including The Sorenson Impact Foundation, Larry H. Miller Family Foundation, Garff Family Foundation, Greg and Jacki Zehner Foundation and ATHOS Private Wealth have embraced a vision of expanding access to capital for people of color. Utah is a place of opportunity – that is the Eccles family's story, and now it will also be Redemption Bank's story.



Legacy

Utahns take immense pride in our heritage defined by a legacy of hardworking, resilient individuals who come together to strengthen our communities. Our vibrant cities and tight-knit rural communities hold a rich history that deserves to be preserved. Nonprofits play a crucial role in protecting this legacy, ensuring that our stories and values endure for generations to come. Awarding more than \$800 million in grants since 1958, the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation is committed to our founders' legacy of generosity and giving back.

MUSEUM OF UTAH / STATE OF UTAH

Utah's rich and unique history has many stories to tell – from its pioneer heritage to the growth of the railroads to the 2002 Winter Olympic Games and more. The future Museum of Utah will celebrate these fascinating aspects of our history, engaging visitors of all ages, and from all over the world. Through a \$1 million grant from the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation, the museum's Utah Inspires Theater will showcase the state's distinctive achievements, attractions, and innovations. As a part of the Capitol Hill campus, the museum will weave the beloved stories of Utah's past and build excitement for the future of our state and communities.



NATIONAL PARK FOUNDATION

Known for our Mighty Five National Parks – Zion, Canyonlands, Arches, Bryce, and Capitol Reef – Utah has some of the most spectacular geography in the country. For over a decade, the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation has provided more than \$1.3 million in grants to support our state's 17 national parks, monuments, and historical sites. These sacred sites are truly national treasures, and it's our responsibility to steward and protect these iconic landscapes for future generations.



UTAH SYMPHONY | UTAH OPERA

Utah Symphony | Utah Opera has been the Foundation's partner for decades. Our founders were champions for the arts and that advocacy continues today, with over \$40 million in grants to date. Utahns from across the state have found inspiration and joy through Utah Symphony | Utah Opera performances and education programs. The organization engages residents in all 29 counties by taking events on the road to offer free concerts in Utah's spectacular rural landscapes. And, of course, this treasured institution is an anchor arts organization in our capital city, bringing world-class performances to the magnificent Abravanel Hall, which was recently named to the National Register of Historic Places.



OGDEN PIONEER DAYS RODEO

Just as the Ogden Pioneer Days and Rodeo celebrated its 90th Anniversary this year, so did Foundation Board Chair and CEO Spence Eccles! With help from a \$800,000 grant from the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation, this year's celebration also featured the unveiling of the newly renovated Spencer Fox Eccles Pioneer Stadium. For four generations, the Eccles family has attended the rodeo, dating back to the 1920s when Grandfather Fox started the Wild West Show, the precursor to today's rodeo. Both the Rodeo and the Eccles family take pride in their frontier heritage and western values.

A highly respected artist, Gary has had over 40 major gallery/museum shows across the country.

This particular painting was part of a 2024 retrospective exhibition in Baker City sponsored by the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation. Baker City sits adjacent to Sumpter, Oregon, home to Sumpter Valley Railway, one of David Eccles' several successful railroad ventures. While no longer hauling lumber as it did at the turn of the 20th century, the historic Engine #3, an original to the railroad, still carries visitors looking for a trip back in time and stunning views of scenic Sumpter Valley.
